- Fit and assemble machined metal parts and sub-assemblies using hand and power tools.
- Use precision measuring tools such as micrometers, calipers, verniers, dial indicators, etc.
- Compute dimensions and tolerances and measure and lay out work pieces.
- Verify dimensions of products for accuracy and conformance to specifications using precision measuring instruments.
- Set up, operate, and maintain a variety of machine tools to perform precision, machining operations such as sawing, turning, milling, boring, drilling; troubleshooting as required.
- Inspect the machined product; correct any defects.
- Completing any required documentation.
